#### **\*PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS**

The Ontario Board of Education welcomes public comment on school issues at meetings based upon the following guidelines:

Visitors are asked to give their names, addresses, and name of group or organization that they represent (if applicable).

Visitors are asked to address the Board regarding an issue only after they have attempted to resolve the issue through the proper administrative lines of authority.

Visitors may be asked to confine their remarks to a specific time limit if there are several individuals who wish to address the Board.

Visitors may not address the Board using language that is profane, repetitive, abusive, inflammatory, disruptive, or slanderous.

Visitors are cautioned that they may not use an individual's name in a public meeting without being held accountable under Ohio's slander statutes. A visitor may request a formal hearing with the Board in executive session that deals with a complaint about school personnel. If that is the case, the employee in question will also be given the opportunity to be present for the executive session. That would result in the executive session being scheduled for the next regularly scheduled Board meeting.
