Administrative Guideline 9160, Public Attendance at School Events, was discussed and revised to allow ALL Senior Citizens who are 62 years of age or older to be eligible to receive a Golden Ager's Pass to be admitted without charge to school events.

The Board discussed May 2022 Levy options.

The Board reviewed and discussed 2021-2022 COVID-19 Protocols and made the following revision:

Effective Friday, November 12, 2021, masks will be optional for all staff and students in all grades. Additionally, outdoor venues and extracurricular activities will not have a masking requirement at this time. Per current federal mandates, masks will continue to be required on the school bus. The Board grants authority to the Superintendent to reinstate a mask mandate, if deemed necessary and appropriate, between Board of Education Meetings.
