

## **NCOCC CUC Self Care Portal**

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## Introduction

This document describes how to use the Cisco Unified Communications Self Care Portal in the NCOCC Hosted VOIP environment. This portal allows users to configure user settings for phone services, speed dial numbers, ring settings, voicemail notifications, call history, call forwarding, and phone contacts. **Note**, not all telephony settings may be enabled at this time.

In addition, NCOCC is using PIN synchronization. This will enable the phone PIN to be synchronized across all of our Unified Communication platforms, including Voicemail box PINs. Users will be able to use this tool to reset their voicemail PIN.

## **Accessing the Self Care Portal**

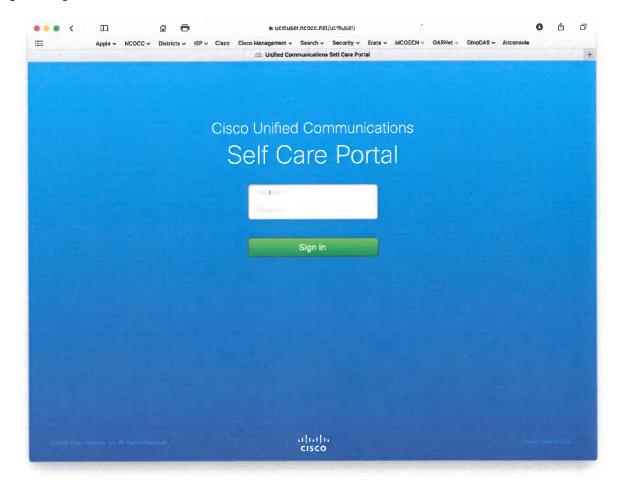
To login to the NCOCC CUC Self Care Portal, follow these steps:

- Step 1 Open a web browser and go to the URL https://ucmuser.ncocc.net/ucmuser/.
- Step 2 Enter your NCOCC Network Account credentials. Note, the Network Account credentials are your

Username and Password used to login to MyNCOCC.

Step 3 Click on the Sign In button.

## **Set Phone Services PIN**

The Phone Services PIN is used for enabling different services such as extension mobility, conference calls, mobile connect and for self-provisioning of new phones. In addition, NCOCC has enabled PIN Synchronization, which synchronizes the Phone Services PIN with the Cisco Unity Connection voicemail box.

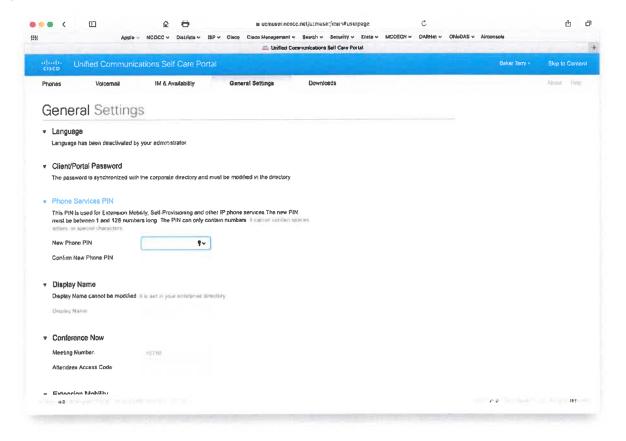
To set a different PIN, follow these steps:

Step 1 From the Cisco Unified Communications Self Care Portal, choose General Settings and click Phone Services PIN.

Step 2 In the New Phone PIN text box, enter the PIN and re-enter the PIN in the Confirm New Phone PIN text box to confirm.

Step 3 Click Save.
