

Golden Agers' Sports Passes

Ontario Local Schools issued Golden Agers' Passes will be made available free of charge to all senior citizens who live in the Ontario School District or are the grandparents of an Ontario student/athlete. A pass will admit the bearer to any school program or athletic event in any of the district's schools when the program or event is sponsored by a school organization and students are the performers.

To qualify as a "Golden Ager," one must be at least 62 years of age.

Passes may be obtained in the Office of the Board of Education.

A pass can only be used by the person who obtained the pass and whose name is on the pass.

Money making programs sponsored by school organizations, but performed by outside groups are not included. Tournaments sponsored by the Ohio State Athletic Association are not included. When a question arises, the individual school should be contacted.
